The minimum entrance requirement for admission to a National Diploma is a South African senior certificate or a recognised equivalent qualification. International students must have their qualifications evaluated by the South African Qualifications Authority (SAQA).

The DUT offers students a range of incentives to assist them in the financing of their studies. Top students receive a remission of fees for 'A' and 'B' aggregates achieved in Grade 12*. Additional scholarships could be awarded to students if they continue to perform well and achieve top symbols while studying at DUT.
